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Terms and Conditions

discovery company shall provide services to the camper subject to the following conditions. By initialing the registration form you agree on behalf of yourself and the camper to be bound by these conditions. These conditions constitute an agreement between *discovery company* and you/the camper and may not be varied except in writing by a director of *discovery company*.

1. Bookings

- 1.1. Bookings are accepted at the discretion of *discovery company* and are not transferable.
- 1.2. You shall fully complete the registration form and supply *discovery company* with all the information requested.

2. Payment of Fees

- 2.1. You shall pay *discovery company* the fees and any additional sums which are agreed between you and *discovery company* for the provision of the services.
- 2.2. The full fee must be sent to *discovery company* with the registration form.
- 2.3. *discovery company* shall not be responsible for any cash payment unless it is handed personally to a director of *discovery company*.
- 2.4. All cheques must be payable to "*discovery company*" (unless otherwise requested by *discovery company*) and crossed with "alc payee only". If your cheque is not cleared by the bank, you will become liable for an additional administration payment to *discovery company* of £25.00.

3. Rules, Regulations and your Liability

- 3.1. You agree to be wholly liable for any and all actions and/or omissions of the camper. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, you shall be liable for any liability, financial or otherwise, or injury or damage to property caused by the camper whilst on site, and shall fully indemnify *discovery company*, contractors and/or employees for any loss, damage, costs or expenses resulting from such liability, injury or damage.
- 3.2. *discovery company* reserves the right to make rules and regulations relating to the camper's participation in the camp. The rules form part of these conditions and will be notified to the camper at the site.
- 3.3. Any failure by the camper to adhere to the rules may result in his/her participation at the camp being terminated forthwith without refund and in such event the camper may be sent home at your expense.
- 3.4. Without prejudice to paragraph 3.3 above, *discovery company* reserves the right to withdraw the camper from any activity at any time on the grounds of safety or unsuitability.

4. Cancellation

- 4.1. In the event of cancellation by you a refund will only be payable if such cancellation is notified in writing to *discovery company*. All cancellations will be acknowledged by *discovery company* and are subject to the following charges: cancellations made 4 or more weeks prior to the start date - 30% of the course fee is payable; 2-4 weeks prior to the start date - 50% of course fee is payable; 15 - 8 days prior to the start date - 75% of course fee is payable; 7 days or less prior to the start date - 100% of course fee is payable.
- 4.2. If, for any reason, the camp is cancelled by *discovery company*, the total liability of *discovery company* will not exceed that proportion of the fees *discovery company* have actually received.

5. Liability

- 5.1. Except in respect of death or personal injury caused by *discovery company*'s negligence, *discovery company* shall not be liable to you or the camper by reason of any representation (unless fraudulent) or any implied warranty, condition or other term or any duty at common law or under the express terms of this Agreement for any loss of profit or any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage, costs, expenses or other claims (whether caused by or negligent or the negligence of our servants, or

entire liability under or in connection with this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of our fees for the provision of the services.

- 5.2. Where *discovery company* provides, in connection with the provision of the services, any goods or equipment or services supplied by a third party, *discovery company* does not give any warranty, guarantee or other terms as to their quality, fitness for purpose, performance or otherwise.
- 5.3. *discovery company* shall have no liability to the camper for any loss, damage, costs, expenses or other claims for compensation arising from any instructions supplied by you which are incomplete, incorrect, inaccurate or illegible, or arising from the camper's late arrival or non-arrival, or any other fault of you or the camper.
- 5.4. *discovery company* shall not be liable to you or be deemed to be in breach of the contract by reason of any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of *discovery company*'s obligations in relation to the services, if the delay or failure was due to any cause beyond *discovery company*'s reasonable control.
- 5.5. *discovery company* reserve the right to alter programmes, activities, itineraries, excursions, age brackets, premises and personnel as it thinks fit and without notice.
- 5.6. *discovery company* will not be bound by any statement unless it is in writing and authorised by a Director of *discovery company*.

6. Medical and Behavioural

- 6.1. Any medical or behavioural problems of the camper known to you must be notified to *discovery company* in writing on the registration form, and in any event prior to the commencement of the camp. *discovery company* reserve the right not to accept your registration on the grounds that any such medical or behavioural problems are not conducive to the camper's or other campers' participation in the camp.
- 6.2. In the event that the camper becomes ill or incapacitated during the camp, you agree to medical treatment being given to the camper if required in accordance with the recommendations of a qualified medical practitioner, including the administration of a general anaesthetic and to surgical operations in case of emergency. Such action shall be taken at your expense.
- 6.3. If the camper becomes ill or comes into contact with any contagious or infectious disease during the 21 days prior to the commencement of the camp, you must immediately notify *discovery company* in writing and provide a medical certificate from the camper's doctor giving approval for the camper to participate in the camp.

7. Jewellery, Valuables and Lost Property

- 7.1. *discovery company* will not be liable for any item of jewellery or valuable property brought to the site by the camper.
- 7.2. *discovery company* will not be responsible for any property left at the site (by the camper or otherwise), and may dispose of any such property if not claimed and collected by you within seven days of the end of the camp.

8. Smoking and Alcohol

- 8.1. Possession and consumption of alcohol, tobacco or drugs by the camper at camp are NOT PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. Please note that if the camper does not adhere to this condition, he/she will be removed from camp in accordance with paragraph 4.3 of these conditions.

9. Publicity

- 9.1. You acknowledge that *discovery company* may use for publicity purposes and without prior notification any photograph taken of the camper at the site, and any statement (whether written or oral) made by you or the camper unless specified on the registration form.
